Steps

STEADY MY STEPS: Psalms 119:133 "Keep steady my steps according to your promise, and let no iniquity get dominion over me." ESV.

ORDERED STEPS: Psalms 37:23 "The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way." KJV We need Father God to direct our steps. Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope." ESV.

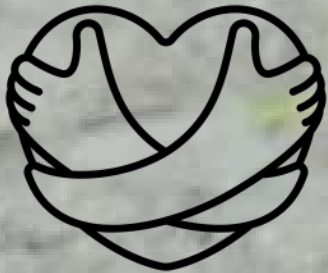

Uniquely Identifiable Individual

Hello! I'm going to pull the cover back and I need you to identify this person to see if you know them. As the assistant pulls the gurney out, then the cover back and you look upon the face only to realize that it's you. In shock, you touch your face, feel your hands, and move your feet only to find out you are having a bad dream. I hear the Lord saying, "how do you identify?" Romans 8:16-17 (AMP) says¹⁶ The Spirit Himself [thus] testifies together with our own spirit, [assuring us] that we are children of God.¹⁷ And if we are [His] children, then we are [His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His inheritance with Him]; only we must share His suffering if we are to share His glory.

What does Identity mean? the distinguishing character or personality of an individual. Identity refers to our sense of who we are as individuals and as members of social groups.

How do you describe your identity? Personality traits, abilities, likes and dislikes, your belief system or moral code, and the things that motivate you — these all contribute to self-image or your unique identity as a person.

Do you remember the day you felt the tug, the pull, the yearning in your heart to come to Christ? Ponder on that for just a minute. I'll wait... Remember that feeling, the tears that rolled down your face. Maybe the peace that began to overtake you because life was hard, or you felt alone, abandoned, or maybe you just heard about Him and had the desire or unction to give your heart to Him. In recalling that moment you said, "yes to the Lord", you became a *Uniquely Identifiable Individual*. You did! Yes! You! You did! Happy, happy, joy, joy, goodness on top of goodness, then boom! Tragedy, turmoil, rejection, loss, sickness, and sadness showed up suddenly. I'm sure you were saying "Wait a minute!" "Hold on!" My life should be flowing real good right now. I just accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior. Somehow, somehow the people that asked you if you wanted to invite Jesus in forgot to tell you that there will be some suffering that you will have to endure.

You read Romans 8 and it reminds you of your identity as a child of God. Right? I'm asking. Right? Yes. I want you to really do a quick soul search to ask yourself how do I identify while I'm walking as a child of God? The Lord knows you've been going through this trial, that issue, that struggle and so on. But I hear the bigger question, or shall I say statement "Lord, I didn't ask for this!" He knows exactly what frame of mind you're in, the intent of your heart, how much you can handle and more importantly, He knows how much you can endure. Child of God, all of this is shaping your identity.



Uniquely Identifiable Individual

You believe, you speak. You speak, you believe. Nothing happens. Now here's the good part. You've been talking about Jesus and all that he's done for you and your soul cries out "Hallelujah, hallelujah, thank God for saving me!" I know many of us have said this repeatedly. But He's still not moving.... Remember I told you that you became a **Uniquely Identifiable Individual**? AKA = Christian, child of God, Kings kid, you know all the things you say you are with your own mouth. Here's where that **(UII)** comes into play. Do you feel like somebody's watching you? Like a hawk soaring in the sky? Son, daughter of God, they are! It's so important that you pay attention to the way you live your life before the people if you've confessed Christ as Lord over your life.

You are now responsible for showing the non-believer or the believer that has lost his faith the way to Christ or finding their faith again. You must do your best not to allow satan to whisper in your ear and shift you from being your best **UII**. I'm not telling you to be perfect, I'm telling you that you're a big brother or sister to someone who's lost their way. There's a possibility that You're a seasoned Christian and you wouldn't want someone to stumble watching you. So, today as you read this, I want you to think about who you are. If you're at your end, you don't know how to endure anymore, you want to give up; get alone, cry, just cry. You don't have to say a word. The one that you gave your life to said "behold, He that keeps Israel never sleeps or slumbers. (Psalms 121:4) He lets you know that he's always watching you and He's concerned about you and your identity. He wants you to be a witness, an ambassador, and child of the King.

So, I encourage you today to identify who you are on earth. If you need help, don't be afraid to cry out to God or another **TRUSTED UII**. What if You are the only bible that someone must read, what's in your book? It's like you being a walking autobiography for Jesus. You know the saying "You don't look like what you've been through."

If you've suffered trauma, adult or childhood, tragedy, abandonment, illness, loss, or anything that might be lying dormant. Seek help, you're not too young or too old. This might be the greatest option for you. This might be a turning point or maybe a breakthrough in an area of your life where you might struggle. Don't be ashamed, go sit, go talk, go be vulnerable allow this to be your process of emptying out the old and letting God replace all the new stuff in you. You can do it! Remember there is someone who's waiting for you and watching your **UII**. Be your best version of the child of God that He called you to be and respond to the Lord with surety when He says, "How do you identify?" You are a child of God who can endure anything because you understand your **UII!**

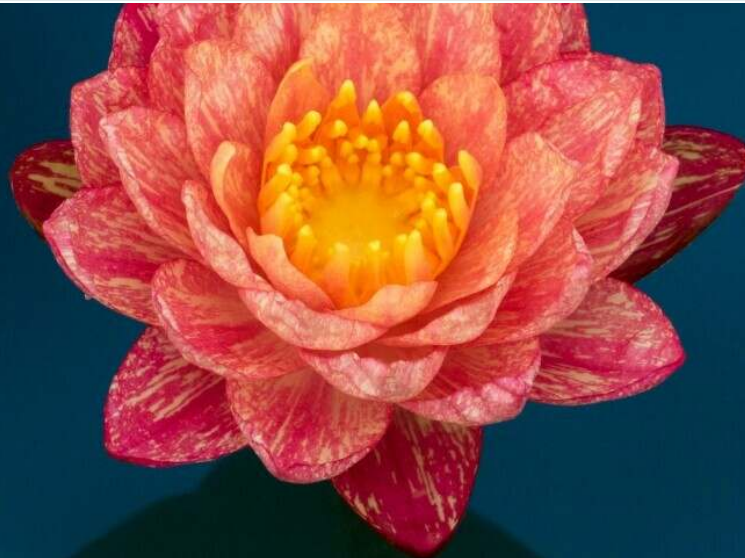
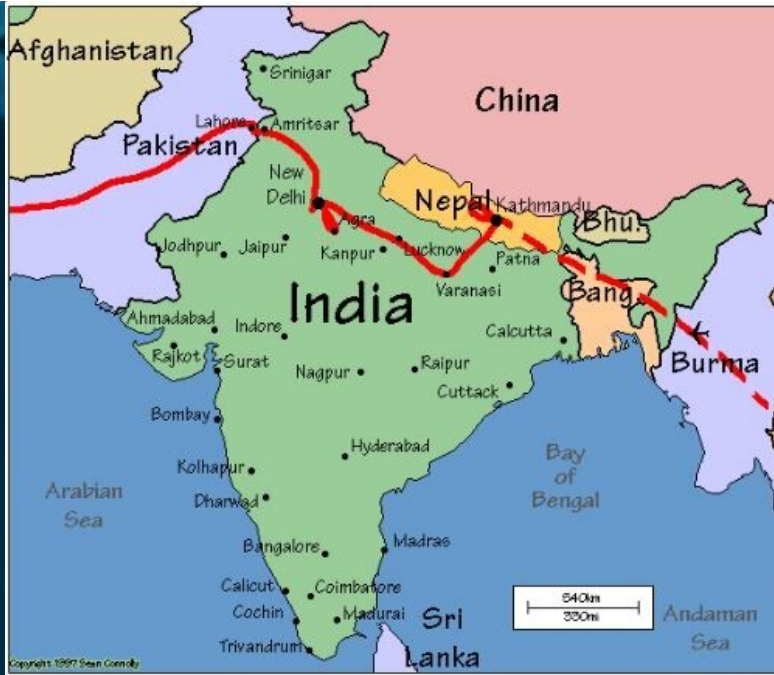
