## *Saved By Grace*

Usually for our SAVE BY GRACE page we would have someone sharing their story of grace. This time I decided to share a story from the bible of someone who made the choice to go their way instead, which cost them their life and people.

A little background first. In chapter 34 Jeremiah continues to prophesy to king Zedekiah and the people of Judah concerning the siege. The reason for the siege is because of their continued disobedience. At one point the king made a proclamation to free the Hebrew slaves as command by God, that every seven years this should be done. They did for a moment, but the king and the people changed their minds (see verses 8-22). Even after Father told them their obedience would save them.

Now in chapter 38:14 the king meets privately with Jeremiah to inquire of God, Jeremiah states in verse 15 ".....If I tell you the truth, you will kill me. And if I give you advice, you won't listen to me anyway." The king secretly promised not kill Jeremiah, nor hand him over to those who wanted to kill him.

Jeremiah tells the king again what the Lord told him to do, surrender to Babylon then he and his family would live, although in exile the king would die peacefully (34:4), and the city would not be burned. If the king did not obey, he would still be captured by the Babylonians and the city still burned to the ground.

Pride is the main culprit, even though fear is working as well. The king says in verse 19 of chapter 38 - "But I am afraid to surrender," he feared those in the city and felt the Babylonians would hand him over to the Judeans who had defected to them. The reassurance came from Jeremiah that this would not happen.

In the end, king Zedekiah did not obey and was captured trying to escape, his sons were killed right in front of him, and his eyes gouged out. Although he was not killed, he was in prison the rest of his life.

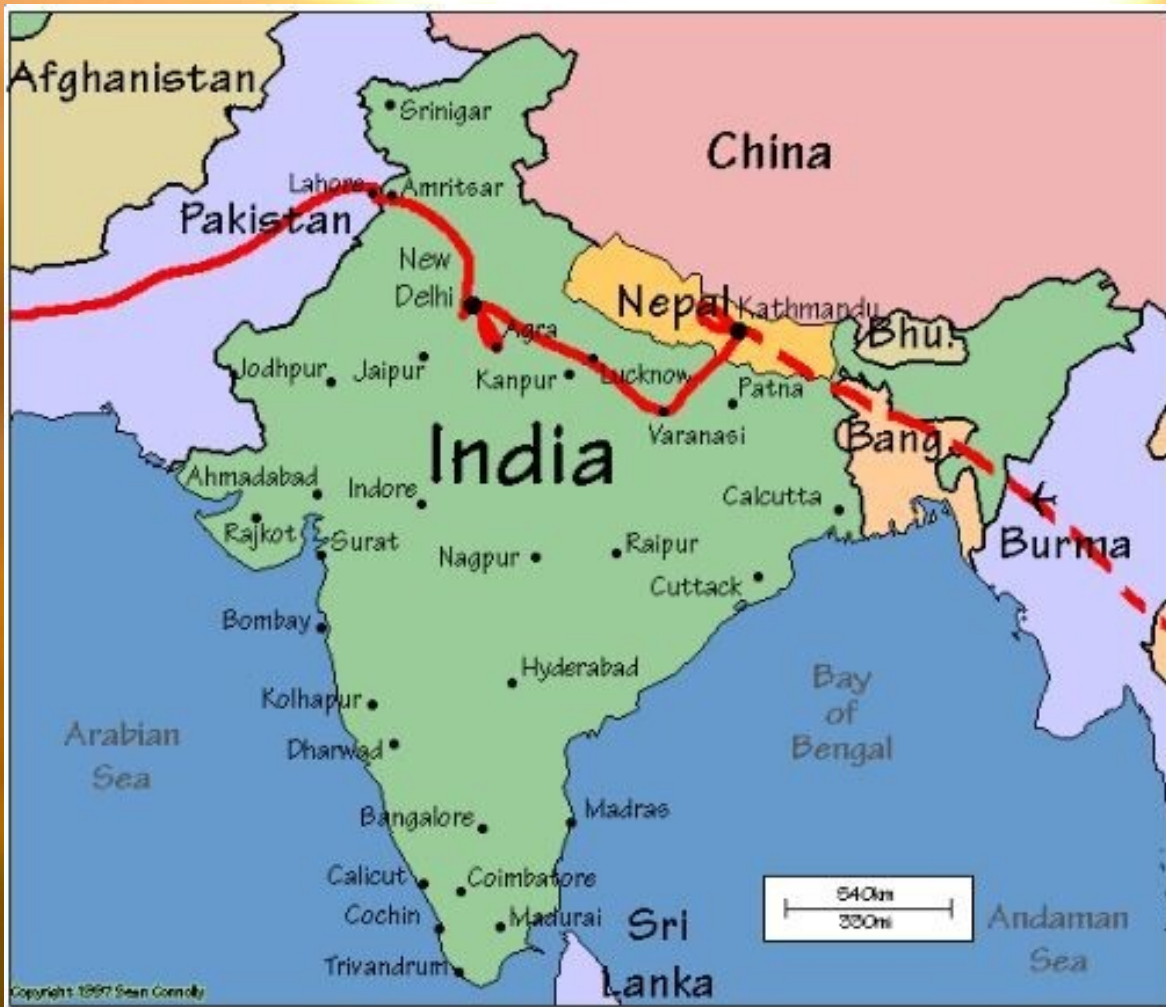
## *"Life Delcarations"*
