### "Prophetic Word"

#### **LOOKING BACK**

People cannot see where they are going because they are so busy looking back, they cannot see. They are constantly looking back; looking back in regret, looking back at what I did not do back then. Father said I just want you to move forward do not look back. You cannot change what was back there, but you can produce, and you can change where you are going, you cannot change looking back, but you can follow my directives and go where I am taking you too, stop looking back. Keep moving forward, moving forward. You got to keep moving forward.

People go into replay, replay; remember when? Remember, remember. Father said that is why they do not go forward; they are so busy back there. I give you a brand new mercy, a brand new morning and what do my people do, they spend time talking about what was going on yesterday, but I gave you a brand new mercy a brand new morning for a new day, to do something brand new, because you can't change what you didn't do yesterday.

My people spend years looking back, they are not looking at what I want to do today, because they are so busy remembering last year. What they did not get done last year, what they should have done the year before. I cannot give them a brand new year, because they are so busy concentrating on last year. That is what you call wasting time, He said, that is how time begins to be wasted, How Satan robs you of your time, because you are so busy back there, even if it is just a glimpse or a moment, that is all he needs, is a glimpse or moment to get your mind going back. Listen to people when they talk, the majority of the time what are they talking about? The past, the past, whether it be yesterday, that is past, isn't it?

The majority of the time my people are talking about past, not now, not present, not forward, but past, and Satan knows this. You cannot change the past, but you can move in now, and move forward, and be in the present.

They regret spending money, but you cannot take back the money it is already gone, he said so I can't produce more because they are so busy regretting the past, 'if I hadn't wasted that, if I hadn't done that, if I had did this with the money,' you can't change it, it's past, but when I give you more; now what are you going to do with what I give you then – that's what matters. Learn from the past, but do not keep playing back there.



Father said people are living in hurt because they are in their past; I want to heal them, heal them of their hurt, but they start talking about the person that hurt them in the past, so they can't get healed of the hurt now, because they are still talking about how you hurt me back then; where is their hurt, their hurt is in the past? So, no matter what that person may be trying to do in the present, in moving forward that individual is looking at what that person did to them in the past, the hurt is back there. They cannot go forward; they are so busy wanting that person to deal with what they did in the past. So, whose captive? Both are captive. Satan is holding them both captive about their past. It could be yesterday's hurt, but they are still there, why? There is no forgiveness, they say I have forgiven you of what you did, but if you have forgiven you have released them from the past. The past is shackles around their ankles; the past is shackles around their arms, it's linking them downward that they can't move forward, because they are so chained to the past, it could be yesterday's past, but they are still chained to it, because you must have a heart of forgiveness.
